PARADE RULES & GUIDELINES Saturday, August 10, 2024 • 10:00 am

If your group is interested in participating in the Bluffdale Old West Days Parade, the application and waiver forms must be submitted. Listed below are the rules and guidelines to be followed.

Parade line-up time: 8:00 am

Location details will be sent in your pre-event packet.

- 1. The official entry form should be received by August 2, 2024.
- 2. ALL participants, including driver, passengers, etc. MUST sign participants form.
- 3. Multiple pages of the OFFICIAL participant form are acceptable.
- 4. Additional Participant Forms can be added until 30 minutes prior to the start of the parade.
- 5. ALL MINORS MUST have a parent or guardian signature.
- 6. Parade marching order will be determined by the parade committee.
- 7. All entries MUST keep moving with the flow of the parade, even when distributing promotional items, candy, etc.
- 8. Candy or other items may be distributed in a **safe** manner to spectators outside the line of march. Please provide your own candy or items.
- 9. Parade units will be required to be in the assigned staging area by 8:00 am.
- 10. Parade floats must meet fire code compliance. (Fire extinguishers are required on each float).
- 11. Number for entry will be given upon check-in & must be placed on the left side of entry.
- 12. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the parade chairman.
- 13. Entries accepted after August 2, 2024 are not guaranteed to be announced.
- 14. All entries will follow the proper ingress and egress routes.

Parade route, check-in location, and approach directions will be sent to your contact person approximately 1-2 weeks prior to parade.

The parade committee reserves the right to cancel any accepted entry at any time should it be determined that the entry does not comply with the parade rules and regulations. The purpose of the Parade is to provide fun, relaxation, entertainment, and patriotism for the citizens of Bluffdale and its viewing audience. The safety and operation of your float, group, or organization is your sole responsibility.
